Spyker Cars : A Brief History

Since the dawn of motoring, Spyker Cars has been combining technical innovation with engineering perfection and superb quality to build products that have become the benchmark around the world. When Spyker started to make aircraft during the 1910s, it introduced a logo showing a wire wheel and propeller. This logo is still in use today. The Latin phrase "*Nulla tenaci in via est via*" in the logo means "For the

tenacious no road is impassable"; a most appropriate phrase given the current economic climate.

In the early 20th Century, Spyker Cars won grueling races, set speed records and became known as the most prestigious cars of the time. Today, Spyker Cars continues to enter the most demanding races, such as the Le Mans Series, where it races in the GT2 class. During the visit by BonusBox winners, the GT2 cars of the Spyker Squadron racing team were in the factory being prepared for the next race; the 77th edition of the 24 Heures du Mans race in June 2009.

After seeing the Spyker Squadron racing cars in the factory, it was time to go for the test drive. Competition winners were taken to an oval driving circuit with corners at a 60% gradient; think of a velodrome and you get an idea what this circuit is like. Photos were not allowed due to the sensitive nature of both the track and the cars, but maybe you can imagine what it's like driving round in a Spyker supercar at speeds over 250km per hour...
